



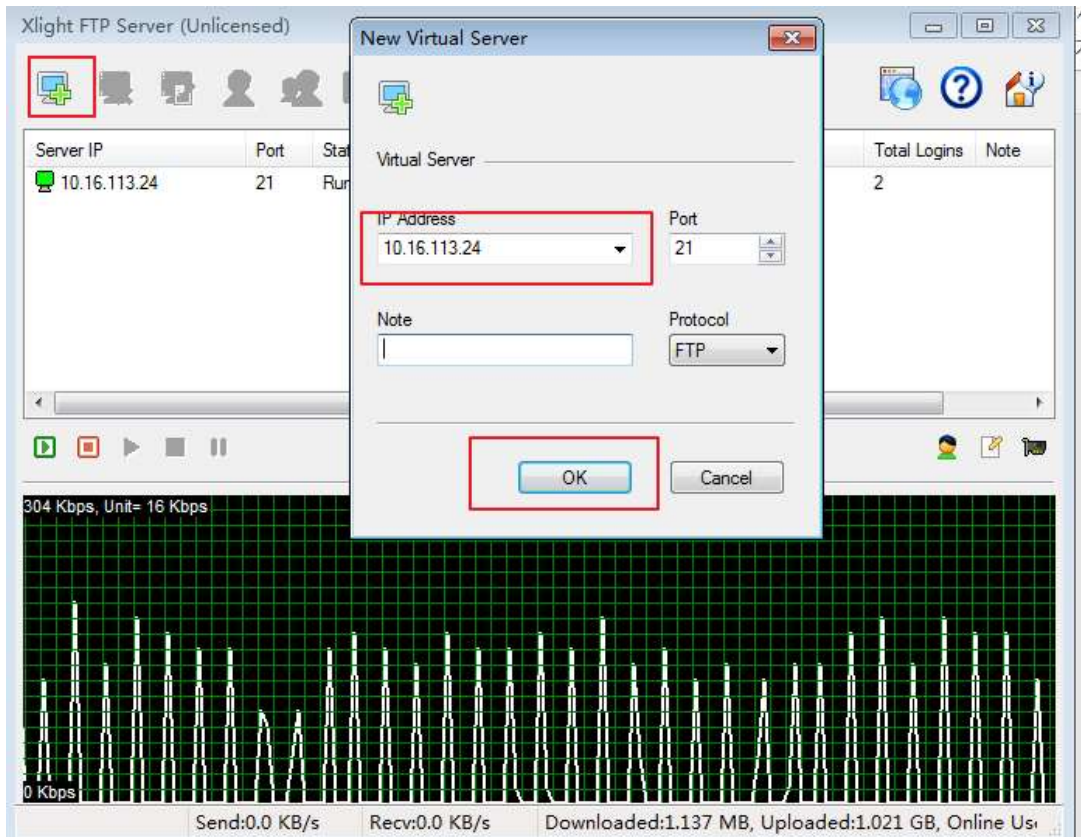

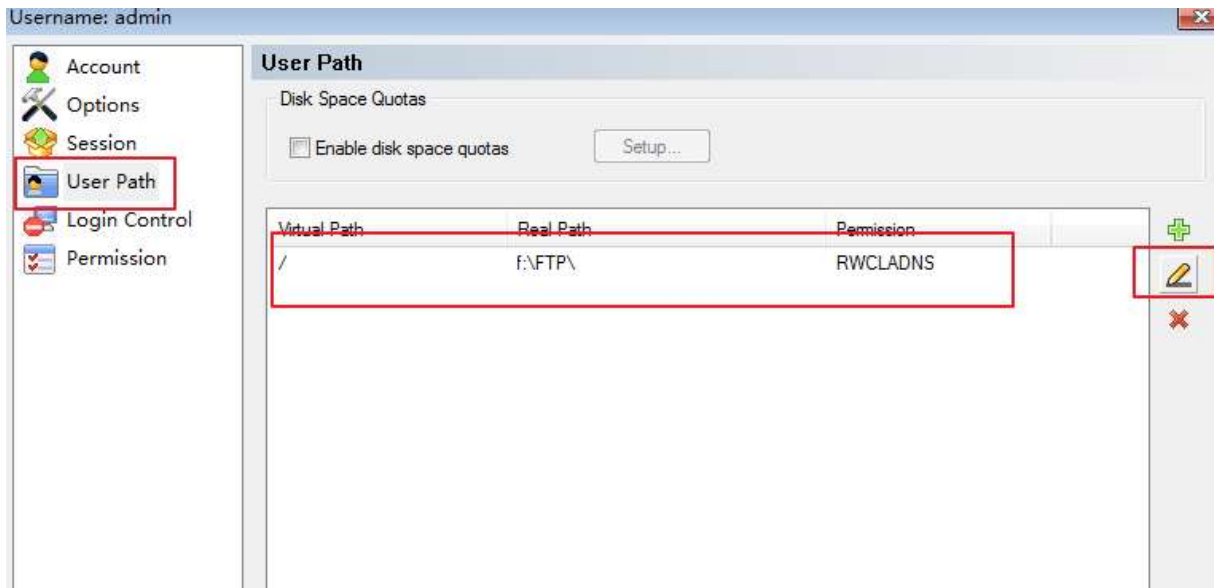
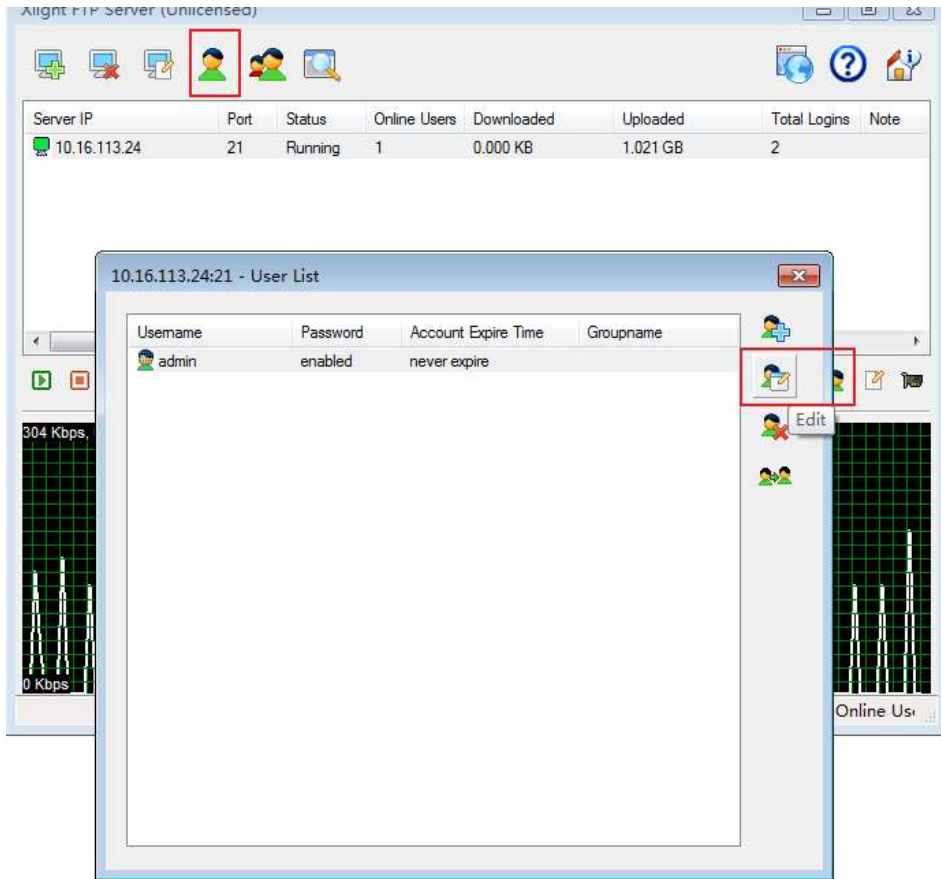
How to Capture Pictures and Upload to FTP

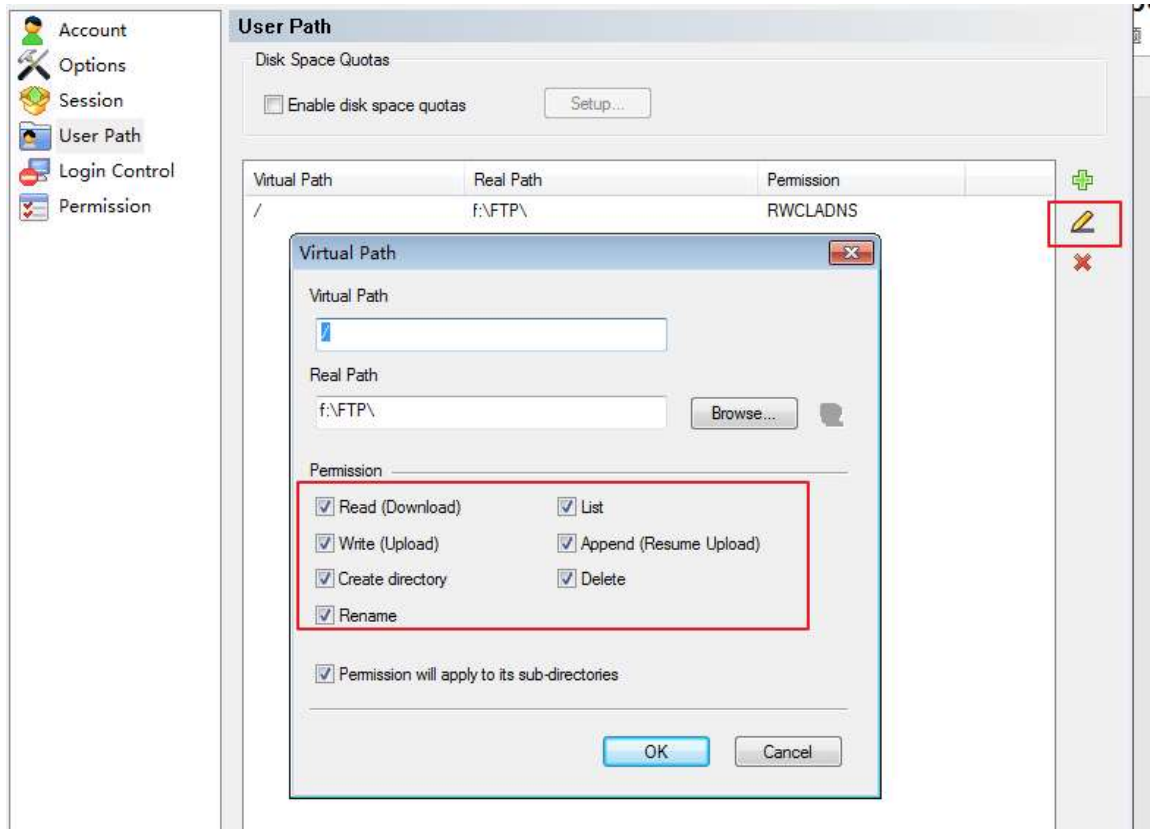
1. Download a FTP server and create a user. The FTP server can be chosen as you like, we take Xlight FTP for example

1) Download a FTP server, click add button, input the IP address of your PC



2) Click User list and Edit Button, create a user, specify the user path and the permission





2. Configure FTP settings of the camera in [Configuration]-[Network]-[Advanced Settings]-[FTP]. The server address is the IP address of your PC, user name and password are consist with the settings in FTP server

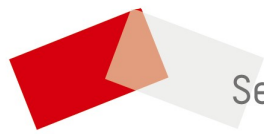
